ABOUT SHAHID CHAMRAN UNIVERSITY OF AHVAZ The history of Shahid Chamran University of Ahvaz, earlier known as University of Jondishapur, incorporates two periods. The first period goes back to the third century when the Sassanid king, Shapur I, founded the city of gendos. It is known as one of the oldest academic centers in the ancient world. History tells us that great scholars from Iran, India, Greece and Egypt gathered here and exchanged views on or taught medicine, philosophy, mathematics, theology, agriculture and other fields. In 1955, the first nucleus of the modern university was formed as a revival of the ancient Academy of Gundishapur with the founding of the Faculty of Agriculture in Ahvaz. It was hence correspondingly named Jundishapur University. with the founding of the Faculty of Agriculture in Anvaz. It was nence correspondingly named jundishapur University. In 1982, however, the university was renamed "Shahid Chamran University of Ahvaz" to commemorate the late Dr. Mostafa Chamran, a US Berkeley Ph.D. graduate, a great commander and a martyr remembered as a leading figure in the history of modern Iran, who fought Zionism and world imperialism.

CENTRAL LIBRARY AND DOCUMENTATION CENTER

As the development of libraries gives quality to the academic activities, Shahid Chamran University of Ahvaz (previous-ly Jundi-Shapur University) attempted to enrich the library's treasuries and establish new independent libraries in dif-ferent units of the university. Therefore, in 1973, in an iconic attempt a 15000 square meter Central Library was conferent units of the university. Therefore, in 1973, in an iconic attempt a 15000 square meter Central Library was constructed in 4 floors on campus. At first, 300000 volumes could be placed in the treasury which has increased to almost 400000 volumes. In this building, the study site was designed for over 2,500 visitors (at a time), and the architectural style of the Central Library has been unique in the Middle East, and the only similar building worldwide could be found in Paris. The library is known as the Rose Building since it is designed in the shape of a flower.

Currently, four decades have passed since the establishment of the Central Library and Documentation Center and today this academic center is considered as one of the largest university libraries in the southwest of Iran. This library has five floors and includes nine sections that divide to headings of Registration & Orders, Indexing & organizing, Borrowing, Education, Information Technology, Reference, Documents, Theses and publications. This library by utilizing the vast collections of Iranian studies, Khuzestan studies, Art books, as well as information systems and full-text databases and membership, has the ability to meet the needs of a great number of researchers, organizations, industrial institutions and executive centers at the level of Khuzestan province and the Region.


