Prof. Dr. Raghu Nath Kohli

Prof. Dr. Raghu Nath Kohli is a veteran veterinary academician with over 40 years of active teaching, research and clinical experience in the field of animal health in several universities in India and abroad (1958-1998), more than 27 years of which has been as a full university professor (1971-1998). As an international veterinary educationist he has also been actively engaged during this period in developing several new veterinary institutions and departments as well as in strengthening several others.

Prof. (**Dr.**) **Raghu Nath Kohli** was born in Rawalpindi in the Punjab province of undivided India on 8 September 1933 and received early education there. He completed his schooling and college education at Agra, U.P. after partition of India in 1947. After receiving his B.Sc. degree from Agra University in 1954, he studied Veterinary Science at Bikaner in the first batch that received the M. V. Sc.

. & A.H degree from Rajasthan University in 1958. He was immediately absorbed into an academic career at his alma mater. During his ten unforgettable years at Bikaner from 1954 to 1963, he had his studentship and professional association with many luminaries including Dr. Mohan Singh Purohit, Col. A.C. Aggarwala, Dr. B.K. Soni and Dr. Ratan Singh (who was the first to introduce live instructional surgery in India). During this period he also earned his M.V.Sc. in the Surgery and Medicine from Bombay University when India's first M.V.Sc. programme in these subjects was started at Bombay Veterinary College.

When India's first Agricultural University was established in Pantnagar, both, Dr. Kohli and his mentor Dr. Ratan Singh joined there in 1963 as founding staff members of Veterinary Surgery. After a couple of years at Pantnagar, Dr. Kohli shifted to Hisar, from where he went on deputation to Bulgaria on Indo-Bulgarian Cultural Exchange Fellowship from 1966 to 1969. The high rating of his D.Sc. thesis first got him 4 advance increments and then an Associate Professorship at Hisar (1969).

When a new veterinary college was started in Ludhiana (Punjab, India) in 1970 he was invited to establish the new department of Surgery, Radiology and Reproduction as its head. He shifted to Ludhiana in 1970 on the same position, but became a full founder Professor of Surgery in 1971, and in the next ten years, established a world class Department of Surgery (then including Reproduction) & Radiology. While doing so, he also joined the team developing the rest of the departments and other facilities including a Teaching Hospital. In his ten years time (1971-1981), the Surgery and Radiology department was being rated as one of the best in the country (if not, the best) with regard to standards of teaching from undergraduate to PhD. level, availability of latest equipment, quality of research and clinical acumen. During his stay in Ludhiana, he availed an Inter-University Teaching Assignment at Baghdad University in Iraq (1976–1977) and another GOI Fellowship under Indo-Polish Cultural Exchange Programme for delivering lectures at Five Academies in Poland (1978). He also had two stints of clinical Large Animal Surgery experience at Utrecht, Netherlands, in 1971 and 1978.

In 1981 he left Ludhiana to continue his spree of developing new institutions. He was the Founder Professor and Head, Veterinary Surgery and Reproduction, University of Maiduguri, Maiduguri, Nigeria, 1981-86; Founder Professor of Veterinary Surgery, University of Medical Sciences, Tripoli, Libya, 1986-88; and Founder Professor of Veterinary Surgery and Radiology, Shahid Chamran University, Ahwaz, Iran, 1988-98. (Continued staying in Iran up to 1999 for writing a Bilingual English-Persian Book)

On his final return to India in 1999 after Retirement from active service (1999 - 2014), he continued his Professional Experience as a Veterinary Medical Consultant and Advisor, 1999 - 2009, Honorary Secretary, National Academy of Veterinary Sciences (India) 2009-2010 and Honorary Founder Editor, National Academy of Veterinary Sciences (India) from 2009 onward to Date (to stay up to 31 December 2016).
